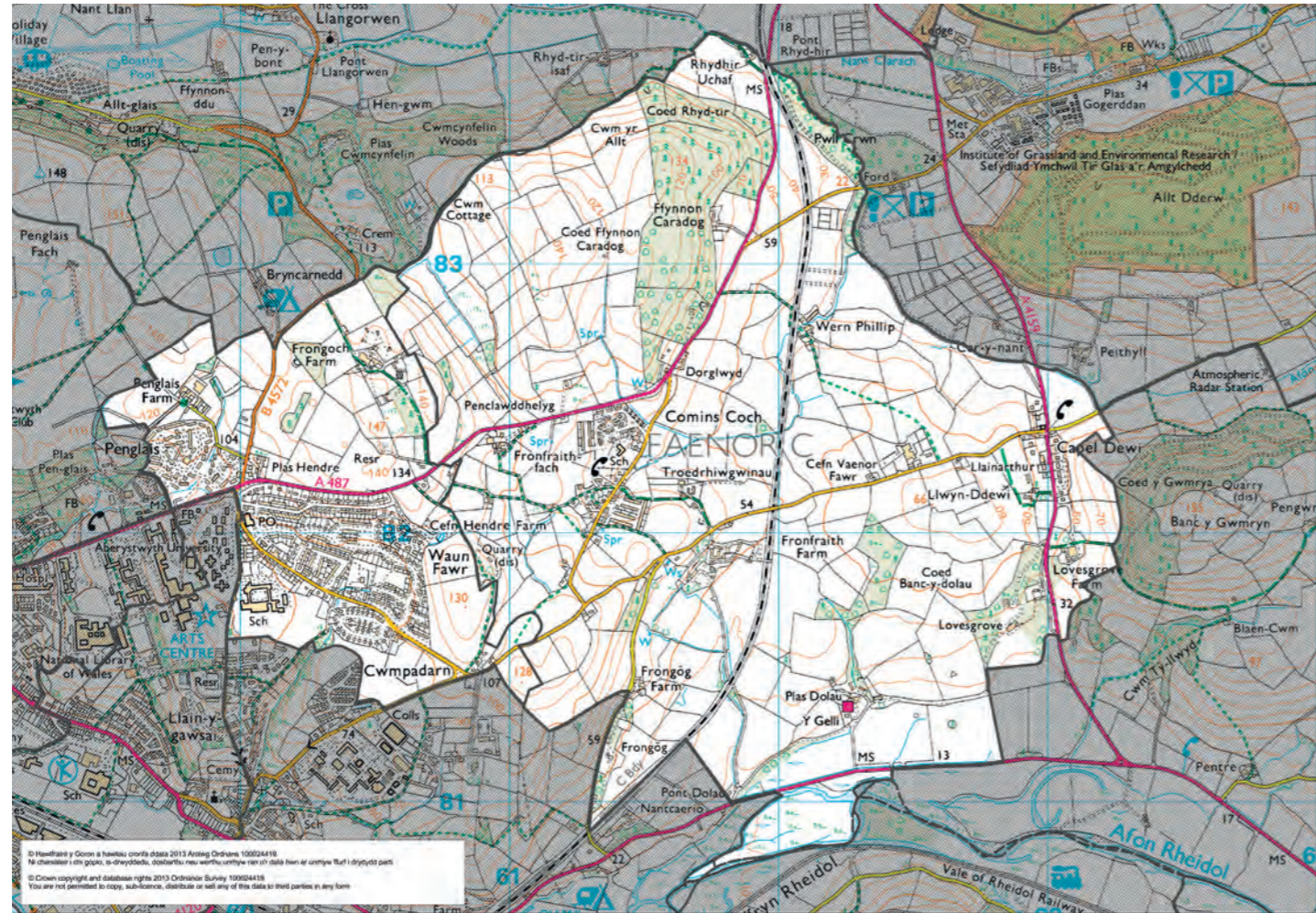


The area covered by Faenor Community Council

Faenor Community Council has two wards: one covers Comins Coch, Capel Dewi and Lovesgrove, and the other covers Waunfawr – designated C & W in the list below.

At present, there are ten councillors who serve a four year term, with vacancies for two councillors in the Waunfawr ward.

Faenor Community Council meets ten times per year on the third Monday of the month. Members of the public are welcome to attend these meetings as observers.

What do Community Councils do?

The Community Council is the lowest tier of local government. Most local issues such as schools, roads, and rubbish collection are actually dealt with by Ceredigion County Council; but Community Councils are directly responsible for services such as grass-cutting, graveyards and playgrounds.

Community Councils work jointly with Ceredigion Council to provide certain county-wide projects.

Community Councils are also *Statutory Consultees* for a wide variety of local and national bodies such as the Fire Brigade who have to consult us by law about their own plans.

All planning applications submitted to Ceredigion Council are sent to the relevant Town or Community Council for comment.

The Councillors are volunteers from your local community who hold monthly meetings to deal with these local issues; and highlight local problems to Ceredigion Council.

How are Community Councils funded?

There are 51 Town & Community Councils in Ceredigion. Each one sets its own precept annually. Ceredigion County Council collects the precept as it collects the Council Tax.

Here in Faenor, if you live in a house rated as Band D, you will pay £1,197.29 this year to Ceredigion Council for the Council Tax. That sum is made up of £970.68 to Ceredigion Council, £206.28 to Dyfed Powys Police and £20.33 to Faenor Community Council. Your local Community Council takes less than 1.7% of your overall Council Tax. Our total income this year from the precept will be £15,417.

For major projects, the Council can get a loan from the Welsh Assembly Government – last year we drew down a loan of £25,975, repayable over a period of 10 years, to fund a major refit of the equipment in the Comins Coch play area.

Beth yw gwaith Cynghorau Cymuned?

Y Cyngor Cymuned yw haen isaf llywodraeth leol. Cyngor Sir Ceredigion sy'n gyfrifol am faterion lleol megis ysgolion, ffyrdd a chasglu sbwriel; ond y Cyngor Cymuned sydd yng ngofal gwasanaethau megis torri porfa, mynwentydd a meysydd chwarae.

Mae'r Cynghorau Cymuned yn gweithio ar y cyd â Chyngor Ceredigion i ddarparu rhai prosiectau ar hyd a lled y sir.

Mae'r Cynghorau Cymuned hefyd yn *Ymgynghorwyr Statudol* i ystod eang o gyrfff lleol a chenedlaethol, megis Dŵr Cymru a'r Gwasanaeth Tân sydd, yn unol â'r ddeddf, yn ymgynghori â ni ynghylch eu cynlluniau.

Anfonir pob cais cynllunio a gyflwynir i Gyngor Ceredigion at y Cyngor Tref neu'r Cyngor Cymuned perthnasol yn gwahodd eu sylwadau.

Yma yn y Faenor, os ydych yn byw mewn tŷ sydd ym Mand D, eleni byddwch yn talu £1,197.29 mewn Treth Cyngor i Gyngor Ceredigion. Mae'r swm hwnnw'n cynnwys £970.68 i Gyngor Ceredigion, £206.28 i Heddlu Dyfed Powys a £20.33 i Gyngor Cymuned y Faenor.
